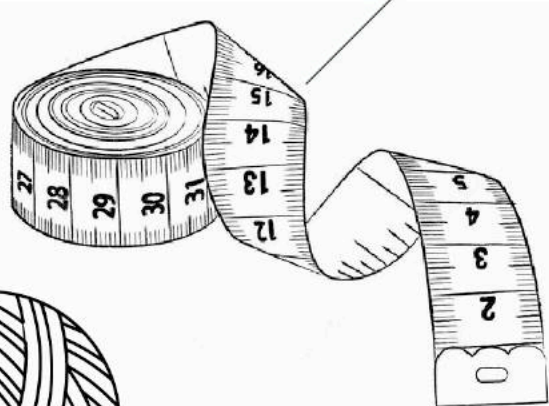
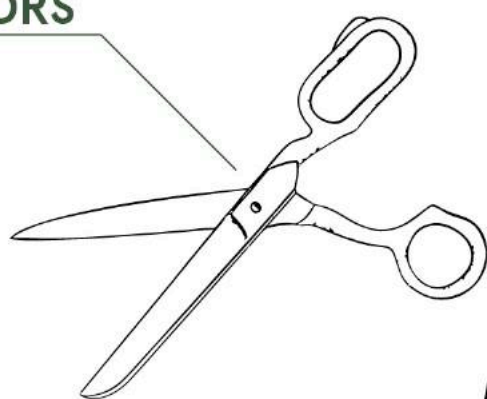
WHAT DO YOU NEED?

2 GOLDEN MACRAMÉ RINGS
5 CM IN DIAMETER



RULER / TAPE MEASURE

SCISSORS



NEEDLE & THREAD



GLUE

3MM MACRAMÉ ROPE

LET'S START!!!

WE START THIS TUTORIAL BY KNOTTING THE HANGER OF OUR BAG. IT CONTAINS OF 2 KNOTTED PARTS, WHICH AFTERWARDS YOU SEW TOGETHER WITH NEEDLE & THREAD.

THE HANGER WILL BE AROUND 45CM LONG, SO EACH PART WILL BE AROUND 22,5CM.

STEP 1: CUT 8 PIECES OF 1 METER FROM THE MACRAMÉ ROPE. AND DIVIDE THEM OVER THE 2 RINGS.

STEP 2: FOLD THE ROPES IN HALF AND MAKE 4 REVERSE LARKS HEAD KNOTS AROUND THE RING... THIS WAY YOU END UP WITH 8 ROPE LEGS PER RING. (FIGURE 1A - 3A)

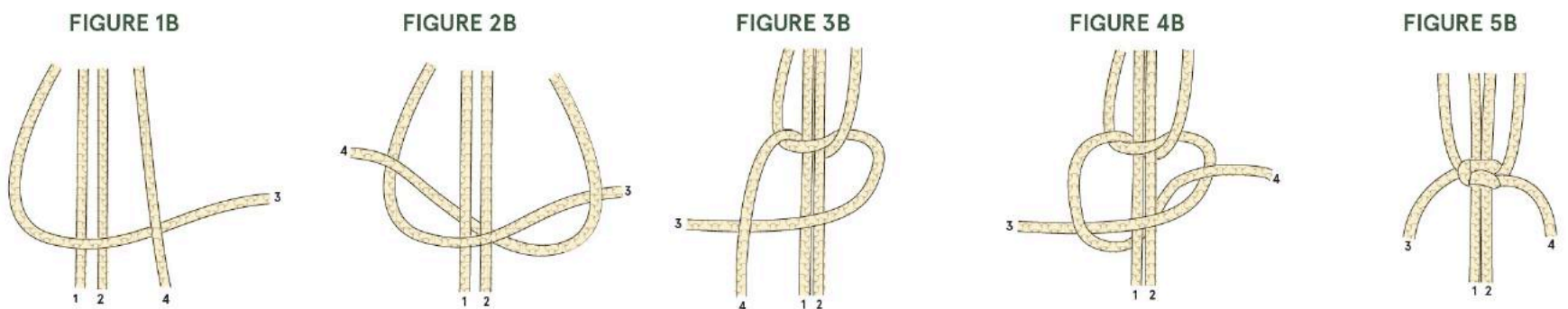

STEP 3: MAKE A SQUARE KNOT WITH THE 4 OUTER ROPES FROM THE LEFT SIDE AND DO THE SAME WITH THE 4 OUTER ROPES FROM THE RIGHT SIDE. NEXT YOU DO THE SAME WITH THE 4 MIDDLE ROPES. REPEAT THIS UNTIL THE END.

STEP 4: REPEAT STEP 3 FOR THE SECOND RING.

STEP 5: CUT OFF ALL LOSE ENDS, TO ATTACH THE STRAPS WITH EACH OTHER, LINE UP THE ENDS AND SEW TOGETHER WITH NEEDLE AND THREAD.(FIGURE : 5C)



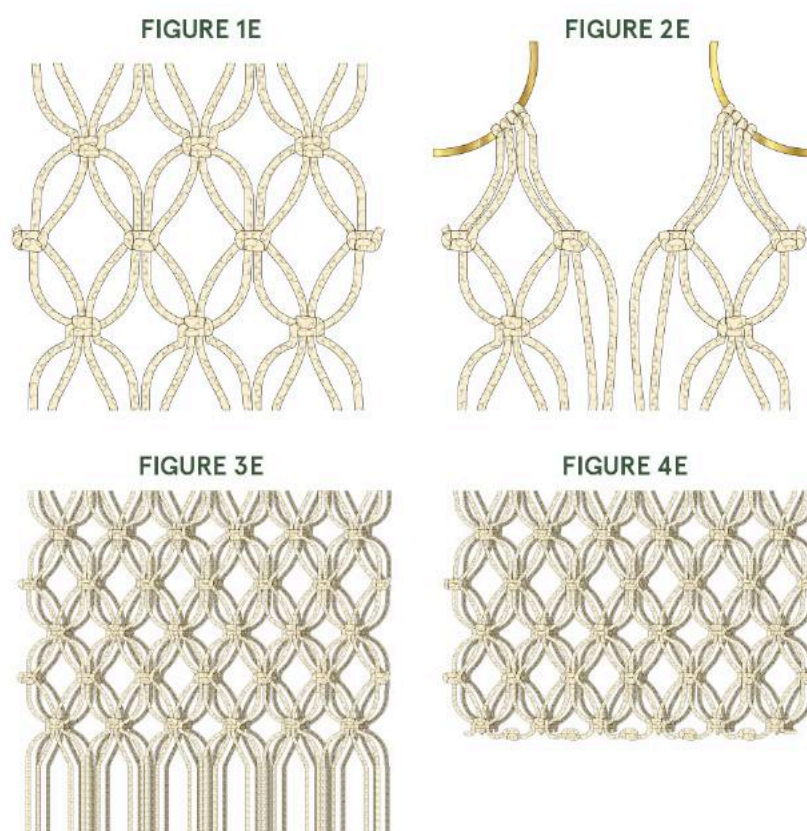

MAKING THE BAG

- STEP 6:** CUT OFF 10 PIECES OF MACRAMÉ ROPE. THE LENGTH DEPENDS ON HOW LONG YOU WANT THE BAG TO BE. FOR YOUR REFERENCE; OUR BAG WAS 38CM...THE ROPES NEED TO BE 4 TIMES THE LENGTH OF THE BAG, SO WE CUT 10 TIMES A ROPE WITH THE LENGTH OF 152CM EACH.
- STEP 7:** DIVIDE THE ROPES OVER THE 2 RINGS. FOLD THE ROPES IN HALF AND MAKE 5 REVERSE LARKS HEAD KNOTS AROUND THE RING... THIS WAY YOU END UP WITH 10 ROPE LEGS PER RING.
- STEP 8:** LEAVE 5 CM OF THE ROPES UNTOUCHED. THE BODY OF THE BAG WILL BE DONE WITH SQUARE KNOTS EXPLAINED ON THE PREVIOUS PAGE. MAKE A ROW OF SQUARE KNOTS...

- STEP 9:** LEAVE 7 CM OF THE ROPES UNTOUCHED. CONTINUE DOING SQUARE KNOTS FOR THE SECOND ROW, ONLY USING THE STRINGS ONE STRAND OVER THIS TIME.

- STEP 10:** AFTER THE 3RD ROW YOU LEAVE 7 CM UNTOUCHED. NOW COMBINE 2 ROPES FROM NEIGHBOURING KNOTS AND MAKE A SQUARE KNOT AGAIN, THIS CAN ALSO BE ROPES FROM THE OTHER RING SIDE. REPEAT THIS STEP UNTIL THE END.

- STEP 11:** TO FINISH YOUR BAG, CUT OFF THE ENDINGS AND FINISH THE ROPE ENDS WITH A BIT OF GLUE TO FIXATE THEM. THEN TURN THE BAG INSIDE OUT.
