EASY HANG-IN-THERE HOME TUTORIAL | MACRAMÉ LIGHT STRING

WHAT DO YOU NEED?



THIS TWISTED MACRAME PATTERN IS SIMPLE TO MAKE THROUGH REPETITION, SO IT COMES TOGETHER IN LESS THAN AN HOUR.

WORK ON IT IN FRONT OF THE TV, AND YOU'LL HAVE AN ENTIRE MACRAMÉ WRAPPED LAMP CORD IN NO TIME.

LET'S START!!!

STEP 1:

CUT THE COTTON MACRAMÉ CORD TO ABOUT 10 BODY LENGTHS OR 10 FINGER TIP-TO-FINGERTIP LENGTHS. FIND THE MIDDLE AND MARK WITH A PIECE OF TAPE.

STEP 2:

ROLL UP EACH SIDE SO IT IS MANAGEABLE AND PLACE THE TOP OF THE LAMP CORD ON TOP OF THE MIDDLE OF THE MACRAMÉ CORD.


STEP 3:

USE THE SPIRAL STITCH TECHNIQUE FROM THE PREVIOUS TUTORIAL (PLANT HANGER) AROUND THE ELECTRICAL WIRE.

STEP 4: IF YOU REPEAT THIS KNOT TECHNIQUE IT WILL

CREATE A NATURAL SPIRAL. IF YOU RUN OUT OF MACRAME CORD BEFORE REACHING THE DESIRED ANOTHER LENGTH OF CORD. IT WILL APPEAR

ALMOST-SEAMLESS. (FIGURE 1A - 6A)



WHEN YOU REACH YOUR DESIRED END, FINISH THE LAMP CORD BY TYING A TRADITIONAL KNOT. STEP 5:

TRIM EXCESS CORD.

TO ASSEMBLE THE LIGHT FIXTURE, HANG A LARGE SHELF BRACKET ON A WALL.
